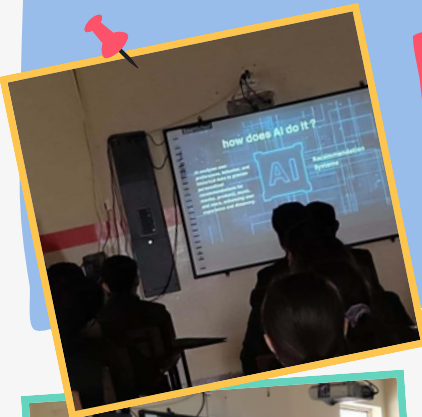
Her success at the event is not only a moment of pride for the school but also a moment of inspiration for fellow students.
